<p><b>JOB SUMMARY</b> Performs fire suppression duties as a line firefighter answering to a company officer and Emergency Medical Services as an EMT. Responds to emergencies via ambulance, fire apparatus, or as a single responder in conjunction with outlying fire agencies. Will be required to maintain skill and proficiency in all aspects of both fire and emergency medical services. Some positions require call back status to assist in covering a particular district. For both Districts, <u>A-EMT and FFT1 is preferred.</u> A residence will be established within 15 minutes of a manned station during good weather and while obeying all traffic laws.</p>	<p><b>Selection Process</b> <b>Review of resume and application.</b> The Applicant's qualifications, education, and employment history will be evaluated from the application/resume received. <b>YOU MUST INCLUDE COPIES OF ALL CERTIFICATIONS WITH YOUR APPLICATION &amp; Include military service papers with honorable discharge.</b> <i>All candidates who meet the minimum qualifications will be contacted to participate in the testing process</i></p> <p><b>Written testing</b> • Candidates will be given a written exam</p> <p><b>Physical agility test</b> • The candidates will then take part in a physical agility test.</p> <p><b>Oral interviews</b> • Oral interviews will be the final part of the testing process. The panel will consist of current firefighters from both districts.</p> <p><b>Hiring List</b> • Based on the scores from the written and physical agility test along with the oral interview, candidates will be placed on a Hiring List for potential future employment.</p>
